Formative assessments	5–7 touch points per unit	
Summative assessments	2–4 per term	
Formative : Summative ratio	30–40% : 60–70%	
Low-stakes opportunities	Weekly	
Feedback turnaround time	48 hours	
Parent update cadence	Biweekly	
Student reflection moment	End of each unit	

Tip: Treat formative tasks as "practice." Record them in your gradebook for visibility, but keep their weight low.
